Criteria of Placements of Student Practical Training

OT at AAUP ensures

- professional standards of clinical fieldwork training
- Adherence to clinical fieldwork procedures: establishing manual

Ethical conduct: ex. informed consent.

Clinical Supervisors

- Internal supervisor: certified OT who has at least 5 years experience
- **External supervisors:** OT holding academic degree /duration of supervision /once a week for a minimum of 2 hours.
 - Proctor of Clinical Training: inspection visits!!

Clinical Supervisor qualification:

- BSc occupational therapy with > 5 yrs. experience, and certified by the Ministry of Health, and Palestinian Association of Occupational Therapy.
- Must pass level I training course (40 hours) and level II (80 hours) of Continuing professional training
 - Refer to Fieldwork Student Manual Pages 11-13 (Fieldwork Staff)
